JDRF

The mission of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) is to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research. Type 1 diabetes is a disease which strikes children and adults suddenly and requires multiple injections of insulin daily or a continuous infusion of insulin through a pump. Insulin, however, is not a cure for diabetes, nor does it prevent its eventual and devastating complications which may include kidney failure, blindness, heart disease, stroke, and amputation. Since its founding in 1970 by parents of children with type 1 diabetes, JDRF has awarded more than \$1.3 billion to diabetes research. Diabetes affects nearly 24 million people in the U.S. – a large and growing percentage of them children. The disease and its complications cost more than \$174 billion dollars a year, and touch as many as 25% of all Americans. Every year, more than 30,000 new cases of type 1 diabetes are diagnosed, with more than half of them children. In total, as many as 3 million people in the U.S. are now living with type 1 diabetes.



The Ride is fast becoming one of JDRF's top fundraising events. Some riders have personal commitments to keep fighting for a cure; others are simply looking for a positive way to give back to their community; all are inspired to meet the challenge. Whatever your motive, the Ride is an unforgettable experience that leaves participants with a feeling of great satisfaction and that will bring us closer to a cure for diabetes, one pedal stroke at a time.

From Janesville (West): This park is located approximately 12 miles northwest from the center of Janesville. Take Hwy 14 west from Janesville for approximately 7 miles; turn right (north) on Eagle Road. Travel three miles north to Gibbs Lake Road. Turn left (west) and travel 1/2 mile to park entrance.

From Evansville (East): The park is located approximately 8 miles from the center of Evansville. Turn left on Eagle Road (north). Travel three miles north to Gibbs Lake Road. Turn left (west) and travel 1/2 mile to park entrance.
